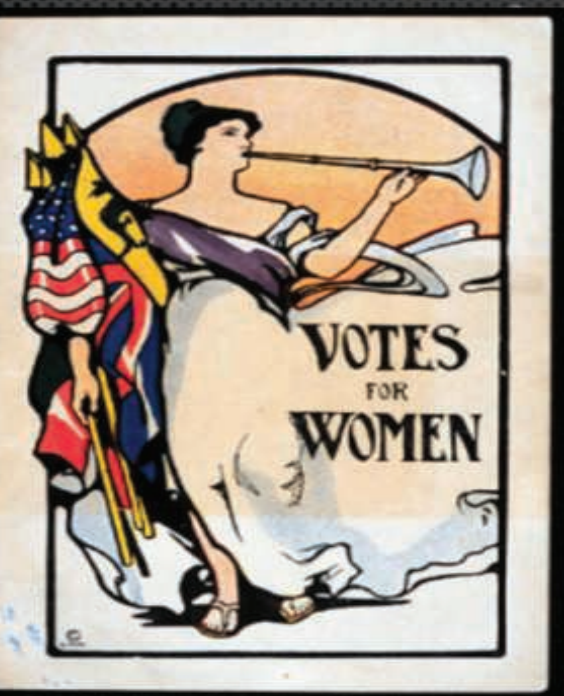

Less than 100 years ago, women weren't allowed to vote, but were required to pay taxes and abide by laws their male counterparts voted into place. Women from all economic and ethnic groups banded together to persuade the men of Washington to give them the right to vote. This exhibition, created by the Washington State History Museum, is the state's lead activity celebrating the centennial anniversary of women obtaining the right to vote in Washington.

Directions to MOHAI

The Museum of History & Industry is located south of Husky Stadium, just off State Route 520 south of the Montlake Bridge.

From Interstate 5 take State Route 520 (exit 168B); Exit at Montlake Boulevard; At the stoplight go straight onto Lake Washington Blvd and continue one block to 24th Avenue East. Turn left into the museum's driveway. Follow road to parking lot.

From westbound State Route 520, take the Lake Washington Boulevard exit; take a right on Lake Washington Boulevard; and turn right on 24th Avenue East into museum parking lot.

Parking is free.

To arrive by bus, take bus 25, 43, 48 or any one of the other 26 METRO buses that stop near the museum at Montlake Station.
